OSAGE COUNTY, KS – Osage County is, as of 11:59 p.m. Thursday, May 21, 2020, rescinding the order implementing Phase 1.5 of the Governor’s COVID-19 Re-opening Plan that was issued May 18, 2020. Executive Order 20-34 issued by the Governor, implementing the modified Phase 2 of the Re-opening Plan, will go into effect 12:00 a.m. Friday, May 22, 2020. Henceforth, Osage County will follow the Executive Orders as issued by the Governor’s office unless modifications are needed to ensure the health and safety of Osage County’s citizens.
